



Altar Room Rental for private Photoshoots

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: How much does it cost? Venue rental for photoshoots only is \$175 per hour. There is a 2-hour minimum charge.

Q: What areas are available for rent? The main gallery. Not all sq. footage is usable due to permanent fixtures in the building.

Q: Can I bring food and drink into the space? There is absolutely no food or drink allowed on the premises during photoshoots.

Q: Do I need to make an appointment for a tour of the venue and ask questions? Yes. We are happy to give you a tour. An appointment is required by contacting Shasta at:

Q: Can I place a date on hold? Due to the volume of rental requests, we are not holding dates without a signed contract and payment.

Q: Do you allow children? The temptation to touch and grab historic items in this interior are high and so is the historic liability. Every rental is a case-by-case basis, and we are happy to have a conversation to discuss your needs.

Q: How many people can I have in the building for a photoshoot? Our location is an intimate setting, photoshoot rentals have a **5-person maximum** (this includes your photographer, and accompanying assistants). We are happy to discuss your specific needs.

Q: Do you have a dress code? No

Q: When can I start my photoshoot? All arrangements can be made assuming it does not overlap another person's event.

Q: What is the duration of a rental? All arrangements can be made assuming it does not overlap another person's event

Q: When can I or my vendors begin to set-up/load-in for my rental? All arrangements can be made.

Q: When do I or my vendors have to load-out? Load-out must be completed the day of the event. We have NO storage space at this location, and anything left behind will impede on the following event rental.

Q: Does the Altar Room require liability insurance? Yes. A standard one day \$1,000,000 certificate of liability insurance including bodily injury and property damage listing us as additionally insured is required. This has been known to cost the renter \$80 (on average). We are happy to guide you through this simple process. You can get a quick quote at: www.theeventhelper.com

Q: Is parking available? Yes, we have a private parking lot. Parking is first come-first served.

Q: What do we have to clean? Clean-up of belongings, and garbage is the responsibility of the renter. The room needs to be returned to the same condition that it was prior to your rental. ALL your items must leave with you after your photoshoot is over.

ADDITIONAL RENTAL FEES AND NOTES:

- There is a 2-hour minimum charge for all photoshoots. There is a \$175 chapel security deposit in addition to the chapel fee. This deposit is refundable IF there are no cancelations, and there are no damages after completion and exit. All fees are due the day you reserve your date with us.
- Fees are due by check or cash. The use of Credit Cards will be charged a 5% fee.
- Rental hours are calculated from the time you request us to unlock the doors, and until the last person exits the building. Additional hours or overages are at the rate of \$175 per hour and is due before vacating the building.
- Movie and motion picture filming is does not fall under our "photoshoot" rental terms. Please inquire about "movie, TV, and private motion filming" terms and costs.
- Due to the value of the interior building content, there will be an event host on site during the duration of your stay.
- Temperature & Climate Control Disclaimer: Although we have air conditioning, summers can be warm, and winters can be cool
